- 1. The Labrador has a 'breed standard' issued by the Kennel Club and the breed council, enclosed is a copy. This is the blue print on how a Labrador should be the shape, size, bone structure, head shape, tail, colour and movement, etc.
- 2. There is only one true type of Labrador. Unfortunately there are many variations seen today caused by those who breed indiscriminately, without the thought for the breed and without any knowledge of pedigree's and genetics. This is most detrimental to our lovely breed. Our aim is to breed a dog of good nature, to match the standard.
- 3. As with any living creature they have their faults, some of which are hereditary. To combat this I have all my breeding stock examined under The British Veterinary Association (B.V.A.) and Kennel Club (K.C.) schemes to ensure I only breed from the soundest and those who most resemble the standard. This is of course no guarantee that all the progeny will be perfect, as nature is a law unto herself, but it is the best I can do to ensure fit and healthy puppies. If you wish to buy a dog of this breed, I would advise you to consult your veterinary surgeon to discuss the breed and any problems it may have before purchase, they are the best qualified to advise you. All checks made by the veterinary surgeon must be at your own expense.
- 4. When I sell you a puppy you will receive your K.C registration form, which will contain details of Eye tests and Hip scores. You will also receive a worming certificate and diet sheet. Never buy a puppy without these papers. Always see mum with her pups.

Your registration form will contain two endorsements:

(1) Progeny may not be registered

(11) An export pedigree will not be issued

- 5. The first is to stop indiscriminate breeding from unsuitable stock. If at some time in the future you think it would be nice to have a litter from your bitch, come back to me to make sure she meets the standard, if she is suitable to breed from, you must then obtain certificates of clearance for her at your own expense. When this is done I will lift the endorsement and help you to find a suitable stud dog with the full knowledge of your bitch's pedigree. No male should ever be used at stud, unless he is of top quality. The 'once only' mating is definitely unadvisable as it will unsettle him. This will cause him to roam and /or mount children, visitors, and even furniture, making him a nuisance to everyone. In fact it is far kinder to have him neutered. If your bitch is not to be bred from please have her spayed after her first season. It is much better for her health than having seasons unnecessarily.
- 6. The second is to stop unscrupulous dealers buying quality puppies from dedicated breeders, to resell at a huge profit, mostly to foreign countries. It is then impossible to confirm their welfare and they may end up being used as breeding machines until they die, or even worse. It in no way effects you're right to take your dog if you decide to live abroad.
- 7. As a breeder I sell you this puppy in good faith, knowing it is typical of the breed and bred from good temperament and soundness. If your veterinary surgeon finds any problem which, in his opinion, renders the puppy unfit for sale I will take the puppy back and refund the purchase price in full on condition that the puppy is returned within four days of the date of purchase. and is in the same state of health as it was sold. Before purchase you should consider that a puppy is a living thing which may become a much loved member of the family in a short time and this may effect what you wish to do if the return of the puppy becomes necessary. I cannot be held responsible for distress or upset caused by the return of puppy after drawing your attention to this possibility. You must confirm before purchase that you have consulted your veterinary surgeon about this breed and any possible diseases genetic, or otherwise to which it is prone. You must confirm that, if such a disease develops later in life after a satisfactory preliminary examination by your veterinary surgeon, I cannot be held responsible. I will take the dog back at any time if for any reason you can no longer keep it. No money will be refunded in this case. The dog will be re-homed through Labrador rescue.
